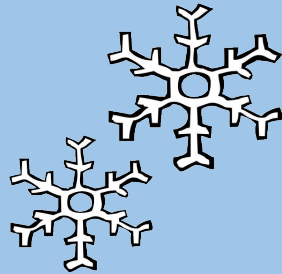

2017-2018 ELECTIONS

President:

- Consistently communicates with CSD faculty, office staff to arrange events, provide information to members
- Organizes and leads both monthly board meetings and general meetings
- Responsible for registering the chapter with the national association and the university
- Reserves room and meeting location through Community/25Live websites
- Maintains the MSU NSSLHA Facebook page
- Organizes the Fall semester SLP Panel
- Attends meetings/luncheons/events as a representative for NSSLHA & the department
- Works closely with department faculty to improve the minor/courses offered

Vice President:

- Assists President in emails and communication with professors and speakers
- Maintains NSSLHA Twitter, Instagram
- Facilitates communication among officers and members
- Responsible for anything needed directly by President
- Organizes the Fall semester Graduate Student Panel



2017-2018 ELECTIONS

Secretary:

- Records membership points
- Responsible for creating and maintaining detailed, organized, and accurate spreadsheets
- Creates and prints NSSLHA active membership certificates
- Maintains and responds to email

Treasurer:

- Collects membership dues and deposits them into the NSSLHA account at Student Services
- Maintains the bank account and keeps track of withdrawals/deposits
- Handles reimbursements for organization activities/purchases
- Checks NSSLHA mailbox in Oyer regularly

Fundraising Chair:

- Plan a minimum of two successful fundraisers for each semester
- Responsible for communicating with and collecting funds from event hosts
- Works closely with Dr. LaPine for raising funds for the Kodomo Center
- Advertises and promotes the fundraisers in the CSD department, school of CAS, and MSU campus/community
- Assists the Treasurer with any additional tasks or programming
